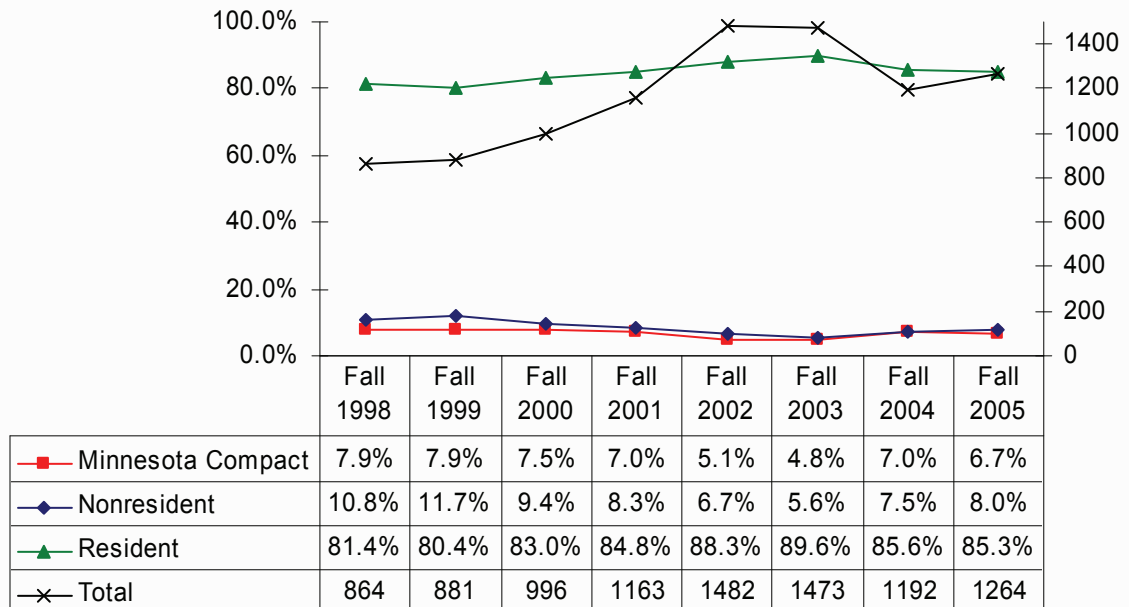


Graduate Headcount by Residence Status



Data Definitions

- Minnesota Compact students are students with legal addresses in Minnesota who have filed for and received tuition reciprocity. These students pay the equivalent of in-state tuition for Minnesota schools.
- Nonresident students include all students from outside Wisconsin, except Minnesota Compact students. International students are included in this group.
- Resident students are students with legal addresses within Wisconsin who pay resident tuition.

Points of Interest

- In addition to the many scholarship and grant opportunities available to Wisconsin residents, UW-L offers “Design for Diversity” and “Return to Wisconsin” grants for non-residents. Additional information on scholarships and grants can be found in the Financial Aid office.
- Approximately half of graduate students at UW-L are enrolled in Off Campus Teacher Professional Development Programs offered through Continuing Education and Extension.
