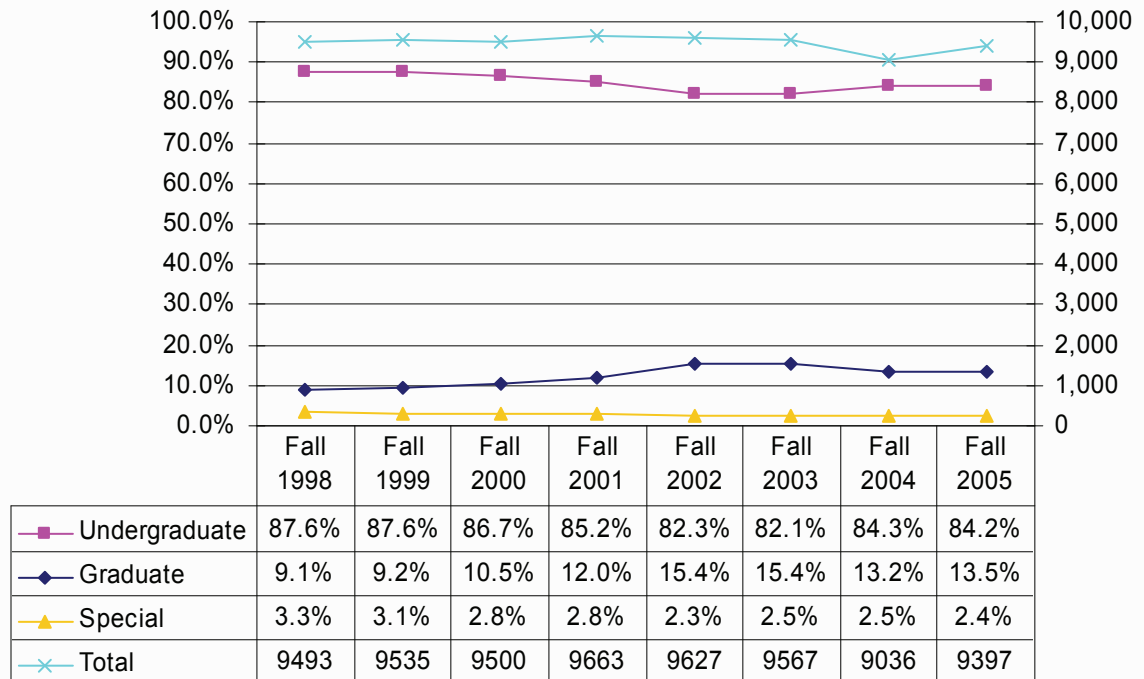


University Total Enrollment 8-year Trend



Data Definitions

- Headcount enrollment is a count of the number of people taking courses as of Official Day of Record (the 10th day of instruction) for the Fall term regardless of how many credits they are taking
- Undergraduate counts include all first-time, first-degree seeking undergraduate students
- Graduate counts include all students enrolled in any degree-granting graduate program
- Special counts include all high school students, students pursuing second undergraduate degrees, or students enrolled in courses but not seeking a degree

Point of Interest

Beginning in Fall 2001, UWL began intentionally reducing enrollment as part of a University of Wisconsin System Administration enrollment management plan called EM21. EM21 was ended by UWSA in late Fall 2004 and UWL has since begun rebuilding total enrollment.
