I. Description of Change/Addition

The Women's Studies minor consists of 22-24 credits including two Introductory Women's Studies courses and seminar or special work. Remaining credits can be taken from selection of courses currently available and offered on a regular basis by other disciplines.

Selections from among the following courses:

- 3 credits - English 285 - Women in Literature
- 3 credits - History 385/585 - The American Woman
- 3 credits - Political Science 317 - Political Woman
- 3 credits - Psychology 240 - Psychology of Women
- 2/3 credits - Sociology 240 - Marriage and the Family
- 3 credits - Sociology 468 - Problems in Family Living

Other courses with appropriate sub-titles will be added to the selection when approved for inclusion by the Women's Studies Committee. The Women's Studies minor is available to all students who choose this offering in alliance with the major of their choice. This minor and the introductory courses will be housed in the College of Letters and Science.

II. Impact Upon Mission of Unit

The Select Mission of the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point calls for a broad base of fine arts and liberal studies and degrees both for the development of students and upon which education in the professional fields can be built. The Women's Studies Minor enhances the broad base of liberal studies by providing people the opportunity to learn of the historical roles of women, the experience of women in today's society, and by promoting a respect of women as human beings by eliminating stereotypes which may limit the development of human resources.

III. Impact Upon Unit Resources

The Women's Studies Minor consists of existing courses from a variety of disciplines. Two introductory courses will be developed by the present Women's Studies Committee. Facilities and instructional holdings are adequate. Secretarial staff will include assistance from existing offices. The program may need some funding for supplies and audio-visual services. The base budget of the university will accommodate minimal expenditures.
