

PROCEEDS OF ALUMNI FUND DOWN IN 1972 OVER 1971.

A sharp cut-back in sizeable non-recurring gifts from non-alumni and foundations to the U.W. Foundation and the U.W. Regents for the benefit of the Law School, coupled with a slight decline in the number of alumni givers accounts for the fact that

the Law Alumni Fund has produced a smaller total in 1972 than it did in 1971.

Alumni and student giving increased from \$53,682.16 to \$57,024.29, an increase due to a gift of \$4,000 from the Student Bar Association.

Alumni will be heartened to know that a number of gifts received after February 1, 1973, has the fund drive off to a fine start for the new year.
