Prof. June Weisberger was a guest speaker at the 10th Annual Conference of the National Center for the Study of Collective Bargaining in Higher Education and the Professions in New York. Her topic was Campus Bargaining and the Law.

Prof. Robert Gordon published an article entitled "Historicism in Legal Scholarship" in the Yale Law Journal (90 Yale L.J. 1017).

University of California-Davis Law Prof. Jean C. Love ('68) has been elected Chairman of the California Law Revision Commission. She has served on the Commission since being appointed by Gov. Brown in 1977.
