I'll reduce the size of the beam during the remaining 4 treatments". So thats the top super news. He said both red and white blood count are normal. Because I have a bit of yellow color, he had blood taken for complete blood chemistry test. I now get up a half dozen times each night. My belief is that the bombardment allowed normal replacement of the bladder closure cells. I'm totally comfortable between times. After treatment I'll build the muscles back up by exercise. I feel fine. is about 80% of normal as I have thruout, with no localized discomforts - and thats mighty good - for eating no health giving salads, no sauerkraut, no horse radish, no cocconut pie, no excess seed bread!
