into real swing on the book job. But I've made real progress. For an important thing I have for sure decided to do the writing and the thinking on the typewriter. I've done enough of it now so I know I can learn.

The biggest job is to think and the words, not letters. I do it well enuf expecially on the short words so that I know I can learn it. Then it has the verificate advantage that I can paste up the stuff and use it in a copy rady for rearrangement and correction. It will be a great step as compared to having to have ever thing typed. I have decided not to worry about mistakes, but rather to consider it as a kind of short-hand and meep going.

attitude and approach to the book which I am determined to use. The present tone could be interpreted as (at best) Someone madea mistake and see here, I'm the hero that saved the day. or (at worst) "Everyone but me is stupid". So — from that I'm trying to change the tone to Heres a book written by Someone who loves life, who lives (not observes) life, Likes business, Believes in Business, Likes me (the reader), is not a cold analyst, is very warm.

We recalled that Nizer took you with him to court. He didn't tell the judge and jury how to do it. Eric Berne doesn't find foult with anyone, he gets you interested in the games — and he sells thousands of book

Can I make the reader happy when he identifys with people in the book, too. I don't know. But I'm going to try.
