In 1938 Mr. Miles transferred to the purchasing department and during World War 2 was purchasing agent for the Locke Insulator Division of General Electric. In 1947 he organized activity now known as Value Analysis for the purpose of bringing better value on a wide scale to the use of materials. He has developed methods and techniques enabling General Electric to eliminate non-working costs from the company's products.

Mr. Miles has been awarded the Charles A. Coffin award and the Navy Distinguished Public Service Award.
