The data summarized in this report were gathered on-line from graduates of UW-River Falls who matriculated following Fall, Winter, Spring and Summer sessions during the 2012-13 academic year. Data gathering began in February of 2013 for Fall 2012 graduates and ceased in November when final reminder emails were sent to Spring and Summer 2013 graduates. All graduates received an initial mailing and at least two reminders. Non-respondents were included in email requests for information in subsequent surveys. For instance, Fall 2012 graduates who did not reply to surveys sent in February and March of 2013 were included in emails sent in June and July to Spring 2013 graduates. The overall response rate in 2012-13 was only 16 percent (230 responses from 1,426 total graduates), which was barely half the response rate for the 2011-12 academic year (30%). The SRC doesn't know why the response rate for this report was so much lower but it is consistent with a generally declining response rate we've experienced with on-line surveys.

As the following table indicates, this number of responses is expected to provide estimates that are accurate to within plus/minus 5.9 percent for all UWRF graduates.

There was relatively little variation in response rates by College, ranging from a low of 11 percent for CEPS and to a high of 15 percent for CAFES and CBE. Graduate students responded at a higher rate (48%) than did undergraduates. The following table indicates that the reliability of the estimates for the Colleges/School is not high and results at the individual program level would be much less so.

Because the response rates to this survey have been relatively weak, the SRC has again created an additional summary table that compiles survey results for the 2009-10 through 2012-13 academic years. We believe this table better reflects the employment and continuing education experiences of our graduates than the single-year tables do. Because of this greater reliability, the historical table is presented first in the following report.
