Historical Note

Graduate Bulletins are annual and biennial catalogs of the Graduate College providing lists of administrators, graduate faculty, and members of the graduate committee. Also included is history of the graduate program, information on degree programs in the Graduate College, degree requirements, and course descriptions. Beginning in 1935, the Summer Session Bulletin included the objectives, requirements, curriculum and course offerings of the graduate program.

Scope and Content Note

Graduate Bulletins are arranged chronologically. The Summer Session Bulletins are included in Stout Series 1 as undergraduate bulletins.

The Archives maintains digital copies of bulletins dating from 2006 to present. Undergraduate and Graduate Bulletins, 1903-2010, are digitized and available online on the Internet Archive which is accessible through the UW-Stout Archives and Area Research Center website. The most recent five years of the Undergraduate and Graduate Bulletins are also available online through the University of Wisconsin-Stout Bulletin page.
