Historical Note

Stoutonia is the official, weekly student newspaper of Stout written and edited by the students. It was first published March 17, 1915.

Scope and Content Note

This collection provides coverage of the events and issues on campus. During the 1930s and 1940s, the Stoutonia also carried news for Stout alumni in the absence of an alumni newsletter. Some of the earlier issues of the Stoutonia are missing.
